Read the following questions. Think about each one. Then select one to respond to - the one that triggered your most engaging thoughts! Write your ideas IN COMPLETE SENTENCES on the reverse side and be sure to answer the ENTIRE QUESTION. If you choose to create a picture, do so at the bottom of the page under the five sentences. CIRCLE the number of the question that you will answer.

1. WHICH CHARACTER reminds you of yourself? WHY? Relate experiences of the character that occurred throughout the book - beginning, middle and end - to support your statement. INCLUDE PAGE NUMBERS. (Connect - connect the text to your own experiences)
2. DO YOU AGREE with the way the main character solves his/her problems? What would you have DONE DIFFERENTLY? (Question - actively wonder, question the author or the characters)
3. Was the ending of the story what you EXPECTED? How would you have CHANGED THE ENDING, if you were the author? (Infer - predict, interpret and draw conclusions)
